Dear REM Participants:

Please be advised that the RE Registrar has extended the deadline of submission of the **Accomplished REC Validation Form until 09 June 2021, 05:00 PM** to give REM Participants more time in confirming RECs issued to them for the said period.

Within 11 – 16 June 2021	❖ RER will notify participants via email that the RECs issued for the subject billing month are final or if it will be adjusted in the next REC issuance.

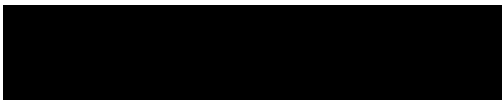
