Ms. Osorio's public and private sector executive career spans over three (3) decades.

Her knowledge and understanding of the energy sector were acquired over a span of four (4) years while she was at the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) where she reviewed proposed corporate operating budgets of government-owned and controlled corporations, including the energy corporations. It was during this period that she served the Office of the President briefly as Director of the Budget and Corporate Affairs Office (on detail from the DBM). Her experience in the power sector led to her position at the helm of the Power Sector Assets and Liabilities Management Corporation (PSALM) as President and Chief Executive Officer (CEO) from 2005 to 2007.

Since 2007, she has played a key role in efforts to share her technical knowledge, wisdom, and engagement expertise in the capacity development of broad civil society organization (CSO) networks and formations who seek her advice in the field of finance, fiscal management, and governance.
